COLLECTION AND SNOW REMOVAL

On collection days, your recycling and/or garbage bins should never be placed on the street. They must be left on your property and must be removed from the side of the road the same day, to prevent the snowplow from damaging your bins.

For the safety of the road, it is FORBIDDEN to push and leave the snow which comes from your property on the road.

FLUORESCENT CIVIC NUMBERS

It is important to remove the accumulated snow around your fluorescent civic numbers so that they are clearly visible to all emergency services. If you notice that your plaque - civic numbers is damaged or missing, please contact the Town Hall so that we can rectify the situation. This is for your protection, in case of an emergency.

PARKING ON SIDE OF A PUBLIC ROADS

It is FORBIDDEN to PARK your vehicle on a public road on the entire territory of the Municipality.
