RABIES VACCINATION CLINIC / TREE DISTRIBUTION / CAR TIRE COLLECTION

Saturday May 13, at the municipal garage located at 2102, 3rd Concession between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., municipal employees will be present to collect used CAR tires, we will distribute trees free of charge to the citizens of Elgin. In addition, veterinarian Dr. Marc Quenneville will be present between 9:30 and 11:00 to vaccinate your cats and dogs against rabies at a cost of \$20.00 each. If your pet received its first rabies shot, it is recommended that it be vaccinated again 1 year later, following the 2nd shot, the vaccine is effective for 3 years

APPLICATION FOR PERMITS AND CERTIFICATES

This is a reminder that before carrying out renovation, expansion or construction work, even if you are planning to demolish whether for your home, your garage, an agricultural building or a shed, the installation of a swimming pool, a silo, for a well or a septic system you must always obtain a permit **beforehand**. You need to apply for your permits in advance! Please note that the inspector has thirty (30) days to issue a permit or certificate of authorization.

Work carried out without a permit may not comply with the standards and regulations in force. Anyone who undertakes work without the necessary permits or authorizations can be given a ticket or a fine, and even demolition could be ordered.

FARM EQUIPMENT ON OUR ROADS

This is the beginning of the busy season for many of our local farmers, you will most likely encounter tractors and other farm equipment on the road. When traveling on our roads, we ask all drivers to be alert, patient and courteous with these large and slower moving vehicles.

As for the farm equipment operators, when travelling on the road, if you leave a trail of mud, we kindly ask that you clean the pavement immediately and also when driving in and out of your field please be careful not to damage the pavement on OUR roads.

Here are the payment methods available to pay your taxes:

- You can pay from your bank account (CIBC, BMO or Desjardins) with the bill payment option with your (10 digit) registration number which is on your tax bill, please choose ELGIN, MUNICIPALITY OF, TAX as the supplier/payee.
 - You can send a check to the Town Hall: 933, 2nd Concession Elgin, QC J0S 2E0
 - You can come to the office to pay cash or by check, if necessary, there is a slot in the middle of the door to deposit your payment.
