We would like to remind you that if you place fences, trees, mailboxes, flowers, etc. too close to the edge of the road, the municipality will not be held responsible for damage resulting in particular from the cutting of grass. We therefore ask you to transplant on your property any tree, flower plant, etc., that you would like to keep. Thank you for your understanding!
