GARBAGE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION

IMPORTANT: The winter collection schedule has started, recycling collection will be on Mondays every two weeks, while garbage collection will be on Tuesdays every two weeks during the winter season.

Here are some basic rules to follow:

- We ask you to drop off your bins between 7 p.m. the day before and 7 a.m. the morning of collection.
- Please do not place your bin on public roads.
- Never place the bin behind a snowbank.
- At all times, it must be easily visible and accessible to the operator.
