Starting April 9, the garbage will be picked-up every week on Tuesdays and this until October 29, 2024. The recycling pick-up will continue to be every second Monday.

Please take note that there will be no special days designated for the big object pick-ups. If you would like to get rid of big objects, such as furniture, appliances, etc., you can do so at the same time as the weekly garbage pick-ups. Tires are not accepted.
