Dear Elgin Citizens,

I would like to take this opportunity to wish you, on behalf of myself and the entire municipal team, our best wishes for 2025. May this new year be filled with wonderful moments, both personally and professionally.

In this winter season, we would like to remind you of the importance of driving with caution, especially when you come across snowplows on our roads. These heavy and imposing vehicles require special attention from motorists to ensure everyone's safety.

Here are some important instructions to follow:

1. **Slow down and keep your distance:** Approach snowplows with caution and maintain a safe distance to avoid accidents.
2. **Use your turn signals:** Always signal your intentions by using your turn signals to indicate to the snow plow driver the direction you wish to take. This allows for better coordination and reduces the risk of incidents.
3. **Anticipate movements:** Be aware of snow plow maneuvers and adjust your driving accordingly.
4. **Stay patient:** Snowplows work to make our roads safe. Your patience and understanding contribute greatly to this collective effort.

We thank you for your cooperation and hope you drive carefully to ensure your safety and that of our snow plow drivers.

We kindly remind you of the following guidelines to ensure the smooth operation of our services and maintain the safety of our roads:

1. Proper Placement of Bins on Collection Days:

- Your recycling and/or garbage bins should NEVER be placed on the street.
- Always place your bins on your property.
- Remove your bins from the side of the road the same day to prevent any damage from the snow plow.

2. Snow Disposal Regulations:

- For the safety of the road, it is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN to push and leave snow from your property onto the road.

3. Parking On Side of A Public Roads:

- It is FORBIDDEN to PARK your vehicle on a public road on the entire territory of the Municipality.

We appreciate your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines, which help maintain the safety and cleanliness of our community.

FLUORESCENT CIVIC NUMBERS

It is important to remove the accumulated snow around your fluorescent civic numbers so that they are clearly visible to all emergency services. If you notice that your sign - civic numbers is damaged or missing, please contact the Town Hall so that we can rectify the situation. This is for your protection, in case of an emergency.

Outdoor ice rink and deck hockey - FREE

As most of you may have noticed, the deck hockey structure and lights were installed at Athelstan Park. The road crew and volunteer firefighters have been working hard to ice the rink so everyone can enjoy it. One of the light poles has a green button to activate the lights. Once this button is pressed, the lights will turn on for 1 hour.
