# **IMPORTANT NOTICE - PROPERTY INSPECTION**

We would like to inform you that an FQM inspector will be evaluating certain residences and farms in order to reassess your property. The inspector assigned to our municipality drives a blue Honda CR-V. He will always carry his ID card and must show it to you. The inspector may take photos, measure buildings, and visit the interior of your residence.



However, we ask you to be vigilant, as unauthorized persons have been known to attempt to visit residences in some neighboring municipalities. If you have any questions, please contact me at the Town Hall at (450) 264-2320; I will be happy to assist you.

### PREPARATION FOR POTENTIAL FLOODING

We wish to inform you that, based on current conditions, flooding could occur at any time in the coming days as was the case last weekend. It is essential that you take the necessary measures now to ensure your safety and that of your environment.

To prepare, we ask that you:

- Remove all objects from the riparian zone\*\* (furniture, tools, materials, etc.) to prevent them from being swept away by the water and causing damage or pollution in the river.
- Bring additional supplies\*\*, including non-perishable food, candles, batteries, and any other essential items, to cope with possible service interruptions.

Your cooperation is essential to minimize the impacts of this natural event. We thank you for your vigilance and cooperation.

### **GARBAGE AND RECYCLING GARBAGE COLLECTION**

Starting April 15, garbage will be collected every Tuesday until October 28. Recycling collection will continue to be every other Monday.

Please note that there will be no designated days for large item collections. If you wish to dispose of large items, such as furniture, appliances, etc., you can do so at the same time as the weekly garbage collections. Tires and construction materials are not accepted.
